lilies...

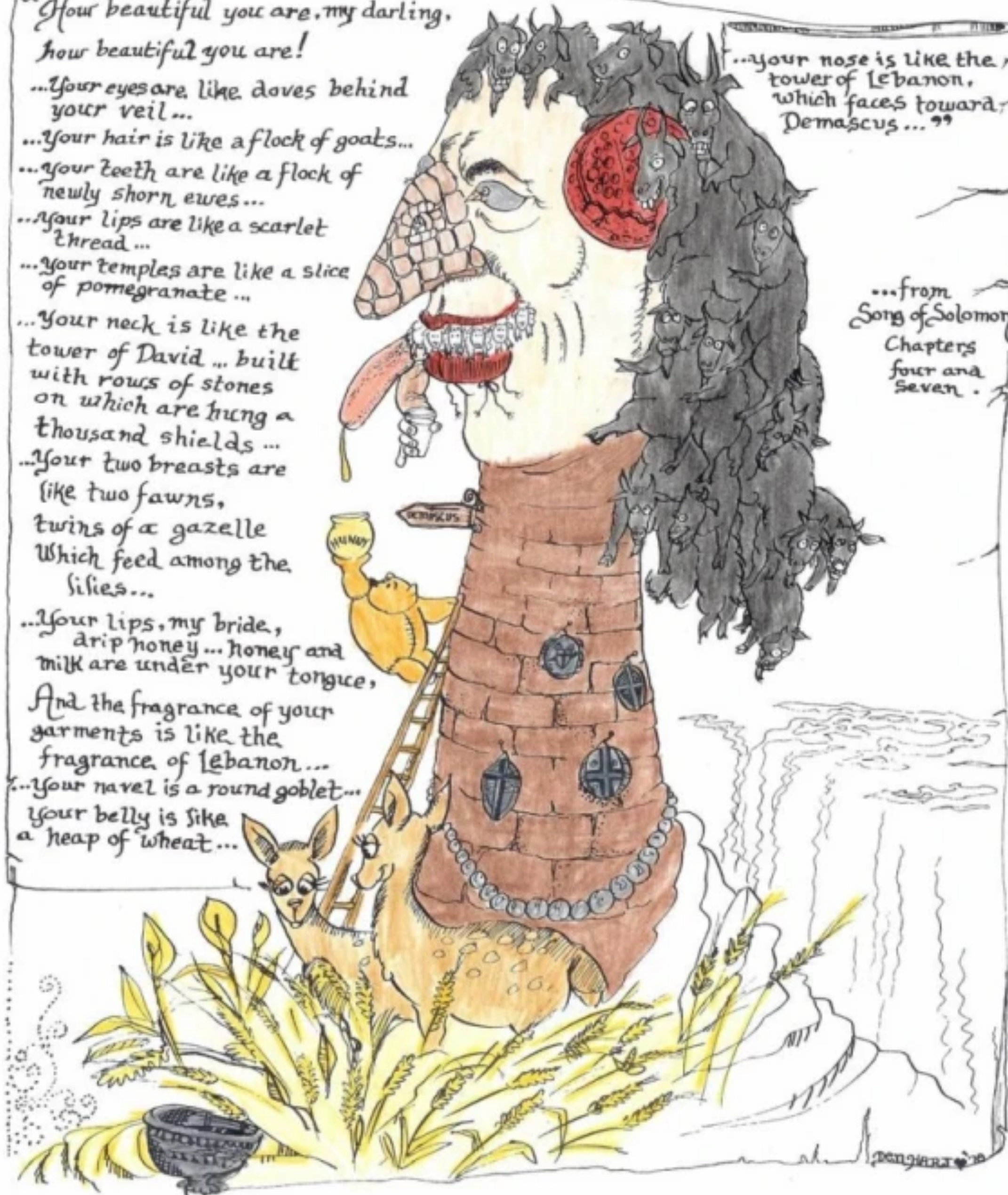
...Your lips, my bride,
